



Administration of Justice Agreement (AJA) Working Group

The AJA Working Group is an internal KDFN advisory body and that works closely with the Kwanlin Dün First Nations Negotiation Team to carry out a number of tasks that relate to section 13.3.17 of the Self-Government Agreement. This section stipulates that KDFN has the power to enact a law of local or private nature on settlement land in relation to the administration of justice.

Some of the AJA tasks include the following:

- Provide advice and guidance with respect to the AJA negotiation processes and issues;
- Provide input and comments on specific AJA negotiation approaches and topics, including the identification of key KDFN priorities;
- Participate in the consultation process with KDFN citizens, including community meetings and updates; and
- Promote effective and timely communication with KDFN citizens with respect to AJA negotiations.
