



Citizenship Committee

The Citizenship Committee is made up of two KDFN Elders and three KDFN citizens that are appointed for three-year terms. The Committee works closely with the Citizenship Registrar and has a number of responsibilities.

Some of the AJA tasks include the following:

- Approving and disapproving applications for KDFN citizenship;
- Determining the citizenship status of a person who renounces or loses their citizenship;
- Reviewing application forms for enrolment and transfers; and
- Recommend eligibility criteria for citizenship, as directed by Council.
