The Kwanlin Dün First Nation is accepting Expressions of Interest for the appointment by the Council of a qualified person as the Chair to the Compensation Board.

Candidates who are not a citizen of the Kwanlin Dün First Nation will be considered.

Term • The term of the Chair of the Compensation Board does not extend beyond January 15, 2020.

Summary of Services

- The Compensation Board is authorized to determine reasonable rates of compensation, benefits and allowances for members serving on the Council in accordance with the following Acts and Regulations:

Governance Act (Kwanlin Dün First Nation), 2016

Act to Amend the Governance Act (Kwanlin Dün First Nation), 2017

Establishment of the Compensation Board Regulation (Kwanlin Dün First Nation), 2017

Compensation Board Qualifications Regulation (Kwanlin Dün First Nation), 2017

Requirements

Persons who are interested to be appointed as the Chair to the Compensation Board must satisfy the following requirements:

- Must not be an immediate family member of any one of the members on the Kwanlin Dün First Nation Council.
- Have demonstrated experience working on boards or committees.
- Have demonstrated skills that include writing, reading comprehension, critical thinking, judgment and decision making, complex problem solving, time management and negotiation.
- Must be familiar with the Kwanlin Dün First Nation constitution, government structure.
- Have knowledge of the Kwanlin Dün First Nation history, culture and community.
- Be familiar with the duties and responsibilities of the Council.
- Have leadership skills and the ability to chair meetings effectively.

Honoraria

- An honourarium and allowances for the Chair of the Board will be paid in compliance with Kwanlin Dün First Nation policy.
