

**NOTICE TO THE CITIZENS OF THE KWANLIN DŪN FIRST NATION
CONCERNING THE PROPOSED**

FREEDOM OF INFORMATION AND PROTECTION OF PRIVACY ACT

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT

- A.** On the 28th day of November 2017, at a duly convened meeting, the Council, pursuant to paragraph 49(1)(a) of the *Constitution of the Kwanlin Dūn First Nation*, by Preliminary Vote introduced for the first reading and later consideration the proposed Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (Kwanlin Dūn First Nation) (the "Act").
- B.** Copies of the proposed Act are available to the citizens of the Kwanlin Dūn First Nation at the Kwanlin Dūn First Nation main administration offices and citizens who wish to submit their opinions concerning the proposed Act may do so in writing by delivering their opinions to the main administration offices located at 35 McIntyre Drive, City of Whitehorse, Yukon Territory, to the attention of the Chief by the 25th day of February 2018.
- C.** Subsection 49(2) of the *Constitution of the Kwanlin Dūn First Nation* provides that if at least twenty-five citizens submit a Citizens Order to the Council to hold a public hearing regarding the proposed Act, the Council must hold such a hearing before considering the proposed Act and must consider a report from the public hearing during the course of its debate on the general purpose and the details of the proposed Act.
