#### **For the Appointment of Two Kwanlin Dün First Nation Citizens to the Compensation Board**

The Kwanlin Dün First Nation is accepting Letters of Interest for the appointment by the General Assembly, on June 24, 2017, of two Kwanlin Dün citizens to the Compensation Board.

#### **Membership Term**

- June 24, 2017 to March 18, 2020.

#### **Summary of Services**

- The Compensation Board is authorized to determine reasonable rates of compensation, benefits and allowances for members serving on the Council and on any other Kwanlin Dün First Nation government branch in accordance with the following Act and Regulations:

*Governance Act* (Kwanlin Dün First Nation), 2016

*Establishment of the Compensation Board Regulation* (Kwanlin Dün First Nation), 2017

*Compensation Board Qualifications Regulation* (Kwanlin Dün First Nation), 2017

#### **Requirements**

Individuals who are interested or are nominated to be appointed to the Board must satisfy the following requirements:

- Must not be an immediate family member of any one of the members on the Kwanlin Dün First Nation Council.
- Have demonstrated experience working on boards or committees.
- Have demonstrated skills that include writing, reading comprehension, critical thinking, judgment and decision making, complex problem solving, time management and negotiation.
- Be familiar with the Kwanlin Dün First Nation constitution, government structure and branches.

#### **Honouaria**

- An honourarium and allowances will be paid in compliance with Kwanlin Dün First Nation policy.
