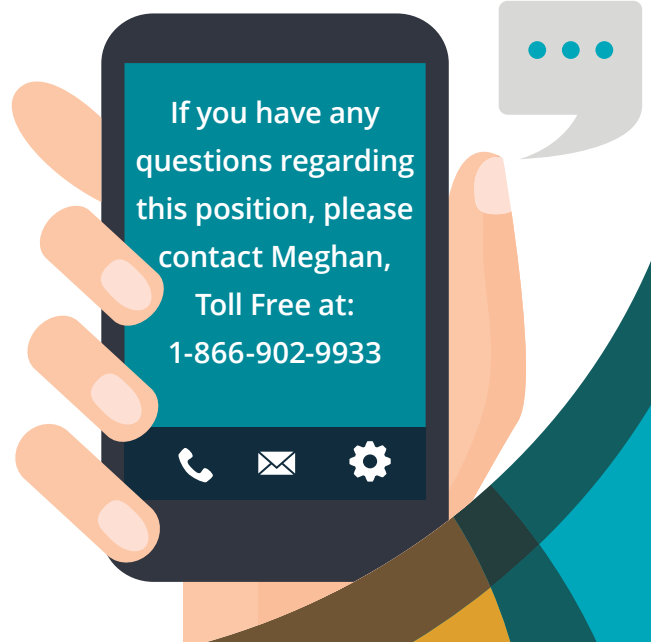
Looking for youth who are interested in the long-term benefit of all Beneficiaries

Eligibility requirements for the Youth Observer position are as follows:

- Must be a KDFN Beneficiary.
- Must be eligible to be a member of the KDFN Youth Council in accordance with Section 35(l) of Part 3 of Chapter Six – The General Assembly, Elders Council and Youth Council of the Kwanlin Dün Constitution.
- Must be between the ages of 14 and 19 (inclusive).
- Must be able to attend 4 Trust meeting per year
- Must have a valid email address to receive Trust communications.
- Must submit a Criminal records Check to the Youth Council, Chief and Council, and the Trust Committee.
- For minors, their parent or legal guardian must support the application.
- For applicants who are attending secondary school, approval must be obtained from the applicant's school. The Administrative Trustee will write a letter to the youth's school to inform them of the official Youth Observer role on the Trust and to seek the agreement from the school.

The Trustees of the Kwanlin Dün First Nation Trust meet four times a year to discuss issues relating to the Trust. If you are between the ages of 14 and 18, and would like to be the Trust's Youth Observer and attend all meetings, please submit your resume to the **Administrative Trustee:** Meghan Shannon.
