Dear Kwanlin Dun Beneficiary,

Please find attached the final results of the Kwanlin Dun beneficiary referendum. Over 70% of eligible beneficiaries voted in the referendum which was one of the highest voter turnouts in Kwanlin Dun's history. Of those beneficiaries who voted, over 90% supported each of the policies that were voted on in the referendum. The beneficiaries have given a strong go ahead for the Kwanlin Dun government to develop legislation concerning how Kwanlin Dun would manage its Settlement Lands and Final Agreement money and how it will consult with its beneficiaries if there were ever any changes to the Final Agreement.

Now that the beneficiaries have provided a strong mandate to Kwanlin Dun to move forward, the next step will involve Kwanlin Dun consulting with its beneficiaries about what the beneficiaries would like to see in the legislation. This process will begin sometime this fall. All beneficiaries, regardless of their location, will have opportunity to provide their input into the legislation that will be developed over the coming months.

I thank all Kwanlin Dun beneficiaries for their interest and participation in the beneficiary referendum and I look forward to working together with you over the coming year.
